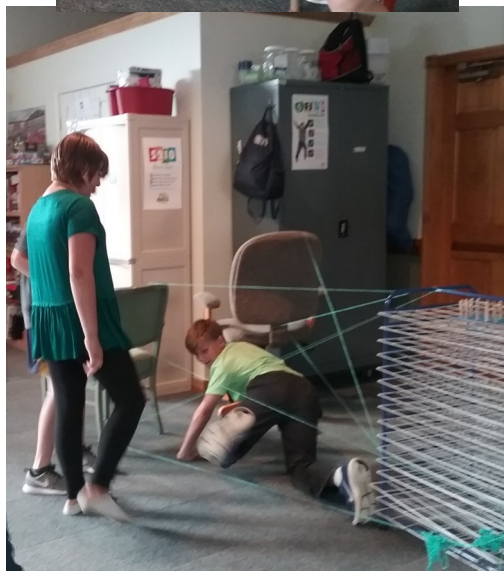
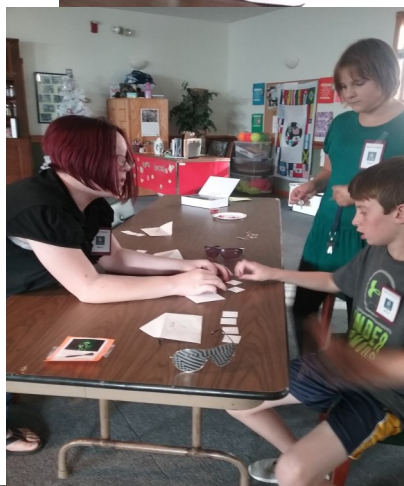


In the Spotlight
